### **IBM Begins Marketing Program for 1,146,000 sf. Of Space in the Hudson Valley Research Park**

*The Space is suitable for Solar, Semiconductor and Microelectronics  
Manufacturing*

WICCOPEE, NY – According to John MacEnroe, President of The Dutchess County Economic Development Corp (DCEDC) IBM has begun marketing vacant space in The Hudson Valley Research Park (HVRP). Included in the space is the former NXP building 322 consisting of 289,275 of former 200mm semiconductor plant. DCEDC will work closely with IBM and their broker Binswanger Technology Group.

In the past there were as many as 11,000 employees on site. Today there are about 6,000 employed by IBM, Vendors and Partners.
