THE HEARING OFFICER: Good morning, everyone. I now open the public hearing in the matter of the application of Shop-Rite Supermarkets, Inc., for financial assistance from the Dutchess County Industrial Development Agency.

Before this hearing began I had marked, in Evidence, as Hearing Officer's Exhibit Number 1, the notice of public hearing in this matter indicating that it would be held today, January 6, 2020, at 11 o'clock, at the offices of the Dutchess County Industrial Development Agency, 3 Neptune Road, large conference room, Poughkeepsie, New York, and that's where we are on this date and time as stated. had marked, in Evidence, as Hearing Officer's Exhibit Number 2, the December 16, 2019 letter from Timothy Dean, Chairman of the Dutchess County IDA, indicating that he designated me as the Hearing Officer in this matter. marked as Hearing Officer's Exhibit Number 3, in Evidence, the affidavit of

publication from the Poughkeepsie Journal indicating that on December 20, 2019 a true copy of the notice of public hearing was published in the Poughkeepsie Journal, and I had marked as Hearing Officer's Exhibit Number 4, in Evidence, the affidavit of Jenna L. Jones indicating that on December 18, 2019 she served a true copy of a notice of publication on the Honorable John J. Baisley, Supervisor of the Town of Poughkeepsie, Dr. Greer F. Rychcik, Superintendent of Schools of the Hyde Park Central School District, and the Honorable Marcus J. Molinaro, County

I will now open the public hearing and ask the Applicant to give a brief statement as to what this project is about.

Executive of Dutchess County.

BY MS. LAMBEK: Sure. Shop-Rite is ground leasing about a one and half acre parcel of --

THE HEARING OFFICER: I'm sorry.

Debra, would you state your name for the

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Shop-Rite Supermarkets, Inc. record.

BY MS. LAMBEK: I'm sorry. Debra Lambek, Law Firm of Debra Lambek, PLLC, representing the Applicant, Shop-Rite.

Shop-Rite is ground leasing a one and a half acre parcel of land on North Road in the Town of Poughkeepsie. They're going to be constructing a 65,000 square foot supermarket. The total cost for the project is about \$13,000,000. That's going to be totally a private investment. There will be initial mortgage financing to start. Shop-Rite has made application to the IDA for financial assistance by way of a sales tax exemption for the construction and equipping of the supermarket. The total job creation is anticipated after the second year to be 130 full-time equivalent jobs. They anticipate creating approximately 145 construction jobs, and, as I mentioned before, they're only looking for a sales tax abatement.

THE HEARING OFFICER: And the sales

Shop-Rite Supermarkets, Inc. tax is on the construction of the building?

BY MS. LAMBEK: Construction of the building and furniture, fixtures, equipment and machinery.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Okay. You indicated in your application that there were -- you expect 6 full-time management administrative positions, 42 full-time jobs and 164 part-time jobs being 82 full-time equivalent jobs on the premises. All of that is still accurate?

BY MR. GRYBOWSKI: Yes. Nothing has changed.

THE HEARING OFFICER: And construction jobs, you indicated about 145 construction jobs?

 $$\operatorname{BY}$ MR. GRYBOWSKI: We have no reason to think that that would change.

THE HEARING OFFICER: And you're aware of the Dutchess County Local Labor Policy regarding using local labor for this, right?

BY MS. LAMBEK: Yes.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Okay. Great. There's no one from the public here so unless you have something else to add I will close the public hearing.

BY MS. LAMBEK: Nothing further.
