BY MS. KRUPIN: Correct.

indicates, your application indicates that you have approximately --- sorry, 520 and-a-half full-time equivalent jobs at the Culinary Institute and it is your testimony that this is a retention project, that is to say to try to retain those jobs, remain competitive in your industry, you are seeking this kind of financial assistance?

BY MR. CAPPILLINO: Sarah Lee is here as our CEO. Do you have anything to add?

BY MS. LEE: No, just that we're happy to assist the Culinary in this project.
